# West Hills College Coalinga – Institutional Effectiveness Standards for Student Achievement

West Hills College Coalinga uses Institutional Effectiveness Standards (sometimes called Institution-Set Standards -- ISS) and Stretch Goals to monitor how well the college is meeting its mission and to set goals for long-term, continuous

improvement.



**Institution-Set Standards (ISS)** are minimum levels of acceptable achievement and are used to monitor institutional performance.

**Stretch Goals** challenge institutional performance by serving as aspirational, long-term goals.

The current standards and stretch goals were discussed by each faculty learning area in spring 2018 and were then routed through Institutional Effectiveness and Accreditation Council and College Council for approval.

Stretch Goal: 300 students per year

### Certificates Awarded


Minimum Acceptable Achievement (ISS): 175 students per year

Stretch Goal: 220 students per year

## Transfers to Four-Year Institutions

Minimum Acceptable Achievement (ISS): 195 transfers per year

Stretch Goal: 300 transfers per year
